The deadline for completing trainings is Friday, December 15th, 2017. If you are a new volunteer please complete your knowledge checks for orientation video and welcome video..

All cookie managers must complete their knowledge check to be eligible for awards. All leaders must do at least one class every year to be eligible for awards.. All service unit team members must complete SU overview, once every 5 years and their position training class once every 3 years in order to be eligible. GSNETX Learning Channel has lots of training that will count if taken before Dec. 15 for required enrichment training for Adult Recognition. Pick your favorite, attend online, then take the knowledge check.

Don't forfeit your award due to not completing trainings. Attached are the spreadsheet to see what awards are available and their requirements to be eligible for them.
