Rogers Wildlife Rehabilitation Center is a 501c3 nonprofit wildlife rescue organization in the Dallas/Fort-Worth metroplex specializing in the rescue and rehabilitation of injured, sick and orphaned birds of all types. Our goal is to restore the health and independence of these precious creatures so that they may be released back into their natural habitat. Rogers Wildlife serves as a sanctuary for the remaining birds, as they are deemed non-releasable due to the extent of their injuries. Please bring some bleach bottles and Rectangular boxes of Kleenex to donate. They use about 10 of each every day, so we would like to lead them up. Here is a list of other items they could use: New 100-U insulin syringes, Unused syringes and needles, Asthma type nebulizer, Heating pads without auto-shutoff, Heat lamps and bulbs, Puppy pads, High-efficiency laundry detergent, Dawn soap, Shovels, rakes, hoes, Pine shavings, Play sand, Trailer of any kind or condition, Riding mower/trailer or attachments, Refrigerator, Electric fans, Extension cords/repair ends, Electrical supplies, AA, AAA, D Cell batteries, Broom & mop

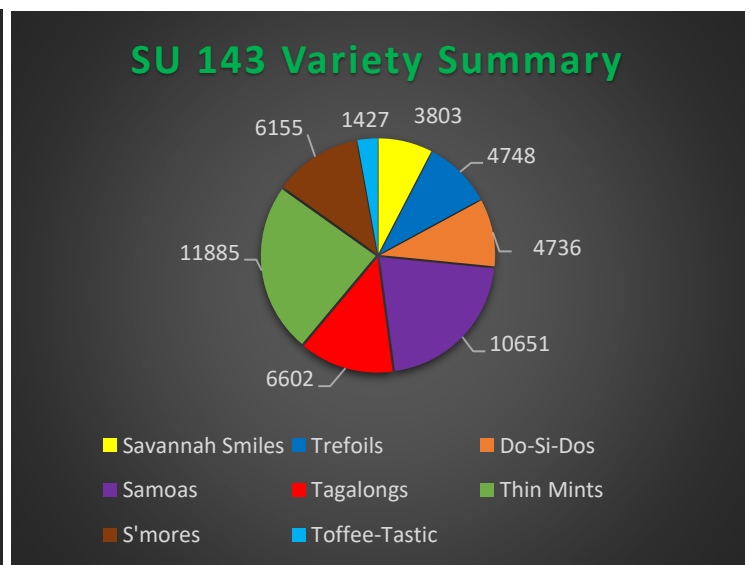
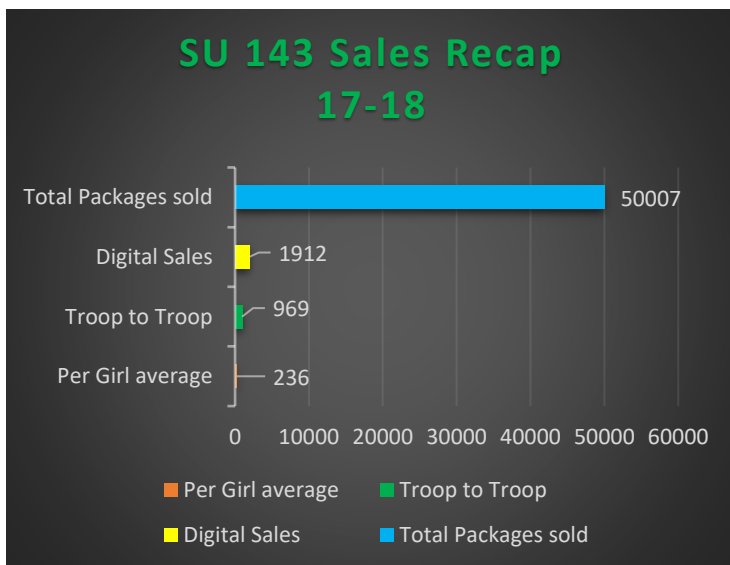

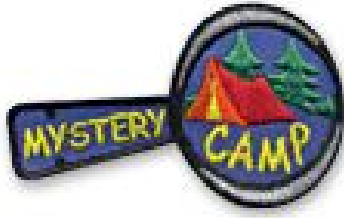
