This Saturday, 10AM! Rogers Wildlife Rehabilitation Center is a 501c3 nonprofit wildlife rescue organization in the Dallas/Fort-Worth metroplex specializing in the rescue and rehabilitation of injured, sick and orphaned birds of all types. Our goal is to restore the health and independence of these precious creatures so that they may be released back into their natural habitat. Rogers Wildlife serves as a sanctuary for the remaining birds, as they are deemed non-releasable due to the extent of their injuries. Please bring some bleach bottles and Rectangular boxes of Kleenex to donate. They use about 10 of each every day, so we would like to lead them up. Here is a list of other items they could use: New 100-U insulin syringes, Unused syringes and needles, Asthma type nebulizer, Heating pads without auto-shutoff, Heat lamps and bulbs, Puppy pads, High-efficiency laundry detergent, Dawn soap, Shovels, rakes, hoes, Pine shavings, Play sand, Trailer of any kind or condition, Riding mower/trailer or attachments, Refrigerator, Electric fans, Extension cords/repair ends, Electrical supplies, AA, AAA, D Cell batteries, Broom & mop

Sachse Arbor Day Clean Up—April 7th

Our SU will be helping with cleanup/beautification for the Sachse Arbor Day Jubilee on Saturday, April 7 from 9am-1pm. We are registered as a group so individuals and families do not need to register on the City of Sachse website. Families are invited to participate.

We will meet at the City Hall Amphitheater and do the cleanup/beautification first. Following the cleanup, there will be bounce houses, games, and FREE TREES and FREE food! (This is for volunteers which would include any girl or family member who comes out and helps.)

Sachse will host an H2O XPO from 11am-1pm. For the H2O XPO: "There will be demonstrations and exhibits held on water conservation, drought tolerant planting, and sprinkler maintenance. Residents that attend the event can earn a \$10 water bill credit by registering on the Water My Yard website or at the Utility Billing Booth that day." Last year the XPO had an interactive demonstration on water erosion.

Some of the events can be incorporated as part of badge or journey requirements. The girls can also get Community Service Fun Patches if they RSVP by March 30 and attend the event.
